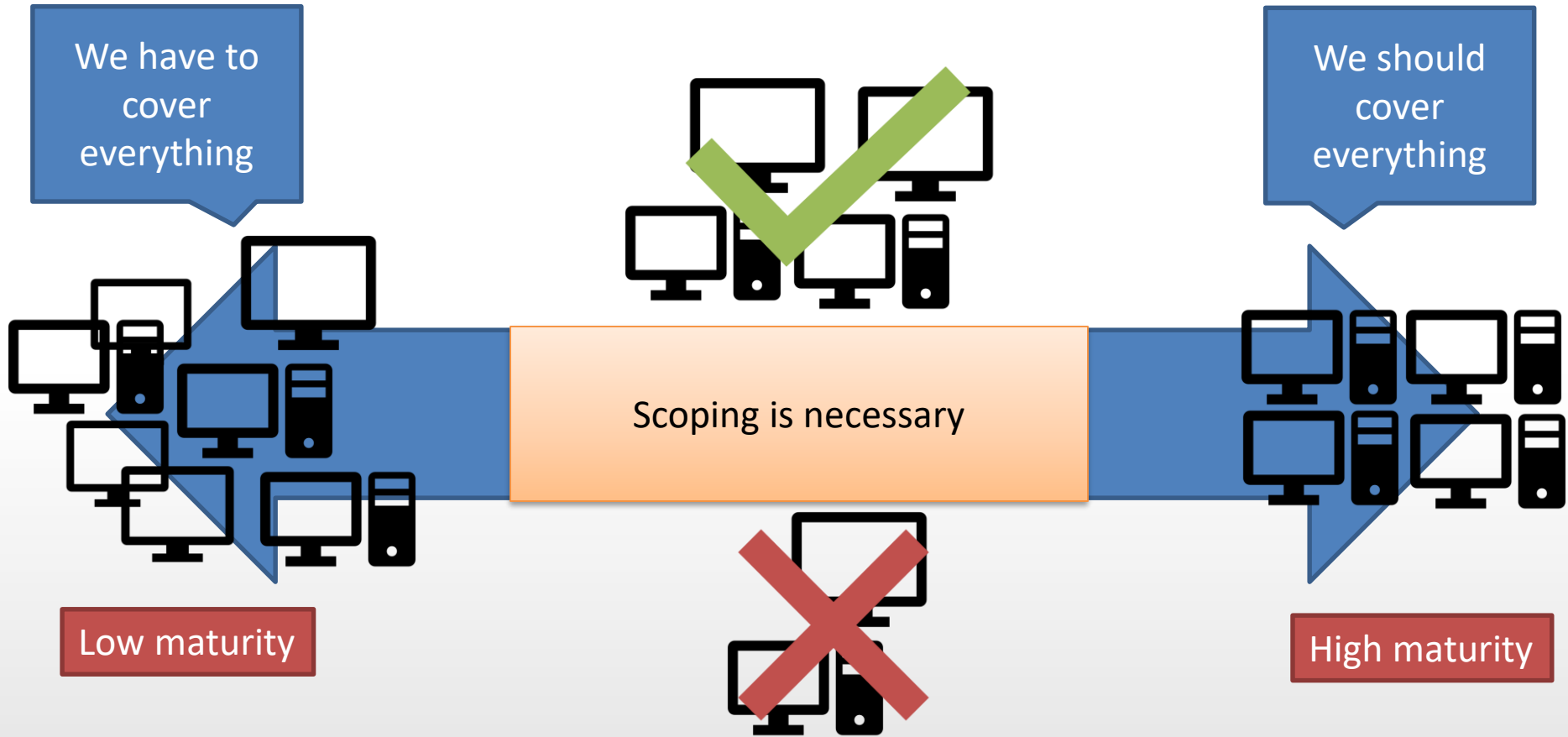

# Maturity

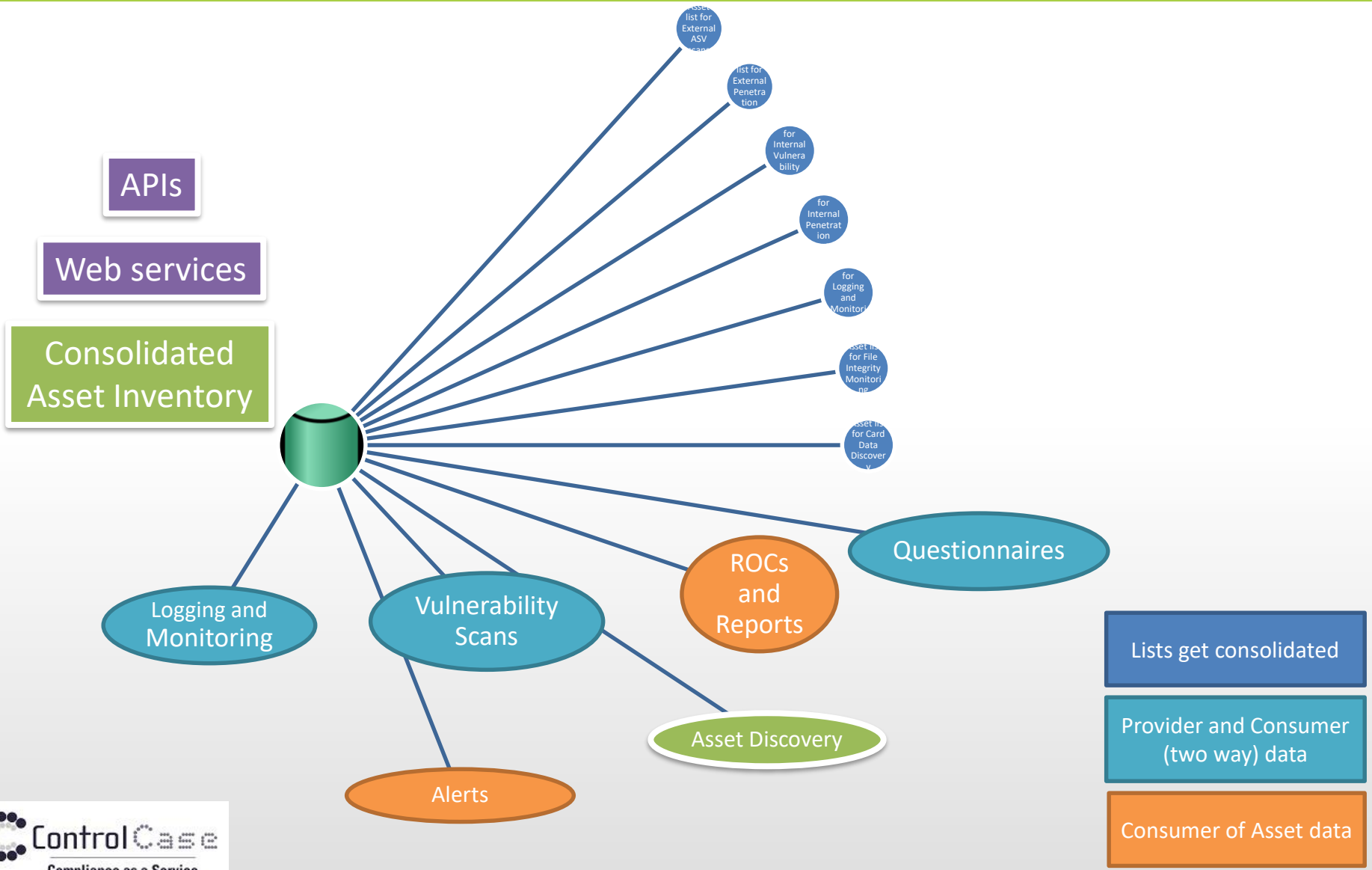
- How mature is your process?

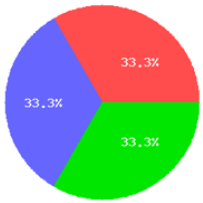

# Timeline for Rollout

- Current Asset lists are being moved over and consolidated into the Asset Manager by end of the year for all CaaS customers
- Additional sources that feed data to the Asset Manager will start to get integrated between now and over 2018
- Sources may be manual – imported lists, typed assets etc or automated – vulnerability scans, logging and monitoring, discovery of new assets etc

# Benefits

- One consolidated list
- Less confusion
- Lesser chance of “slipping through the cracks”
- Significantly better monitoring
- Significantly lower need for data gathering from you
  - › Less data entry
  - › More verification
- Provides a basis for future automation
